Old Business

- Reports:
 - Beth Medaugh presented additional information about CE requirements for physicians
 - A comment was made that the pharmacy schools pay for their student’s internships & medical schools pay the students as well as the faculty for internships

New Business

- Plan for the day is to break up into 3 groups and work on action plans
 - Group 1 focusing on educational needs of nurses
 - Linda Stoverock is chair; Karen Niese is secretary.
 - Group 2 focusing on increasing the number of BSN nurses
 - Joyce Morey is chair
 - Group 3 focusing on establishing a strategic plan to develop nurse leaders
 - Carol Karrer is the chair. She was ill.
- Discussion followed in an attempt to clarify the goals for the day
 - What are the expected competencies of health care workers in 2015?

- Focus on all acute care beds in the hospital and care delivered in one location?
 - What will be the role of the professional nurse?
 - How will curriculums throughout the state match these expectations? How will global curriculums facilitate the education of the nurse in 2015?
 - What care will be out-sourced and in-sourced?
 - Will there be differentiated practice?
 - What is the practice of the ADN nurse? Look to AONE for guidelines on this.
 - Is there an expectation that the BSN will be the entry level for nurses?
 - Focus should be on outcomes and evidence based practice.
 - How is continued nursing competency assured?
 - Communication and leadership skills must be the cornerstone of future nursing education.
- Turn Around Ohio Document
- Jan Lanier referenced this document as a source of information for the groups
 - When asked what Jan saw as legislative foci of the future she commented:
 - Support for Nurse Education Assistance Loan
 - Realization that the current health care system is not working for many people and needs to be “fixed”
 - Prevention and services to the people versus people to the services i.e. Health Departments, school based clinics, mobile care units
