Susan Zabo presented the topic on P2 Universities. P2 stands for Pollution Prevention. P2 University began in 2001 with the concept to develop a program to work for nurses. The information had been presented to plant services, safety officers, housekeeping, central supply, etc.

The first mini grant application of P2 University for Nurses: Train-the-Trainer was not approved. The second application, P2 University for Nurse Leaders, will be reviewed by May 2008. This is a Train-the-Trainer program that will be developed and presented by Holly Shaner and Glenn McRae of CGH Environmental. If it is approved, this will be the next project for the Red Team and an article can be placed in The Ohio Nurse publication.

Next Meeting: Need to get approval of the White Paper and determine who and how to distribute the Paper. The Group of Twenty needs to approve it as well. The next meeting date for the Red Team will be determined at the March meeting of the four 2015 teams.
